Not long now to the events arranged in Felixstowe to mark this wonderful milestone in the story of our connection with Wesel. All members should have received an invitation to the Reception in Harvest House on Friday 19th April. If you haven't please let me know and I'll make sure yours is sent (emailed or posted).

The Reception has been designed firstly to celebrate the anniversary by renewing the Bond of Friendship signed in 1974 and secondly to make public our incredible 50 year history by the launch of Karl Hoemberg's "History from before 1974 to 2024".

In a change of plans, the Saturday evening event will now be held at "SeaYou" located near Martello Park at the end of the prom (*not the Orwell Hotel as shown in our December 2023 Newsletter*)

7pm to 11pm, buffet at 8pm, and music and dancing and a Tombola

Sunday 21st is a free day with an option to use "the Hut" on the prom.

VISIT WESEL IN 2024 FOR THEIR 50TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS

Wesel's celebrations will coincide with their annual Culture Weekend. The proposal is -

Travel Timetable - outward

20.00 Thursday 19th September - depart by coach from Felixstowe train station car park to Harwich International ferry terminal to depart on the Stena 23.00 sailing (overnight cabin)

08.00 Friday 20th September arrive Hook of Holland to board our private coach service.

Arrive Wesel Kaiserhof Hotel by lunchtime and book into hotel (or the Welcome Hotel) or be met by hosts.

Travel Time table - return

09.00 (estimated) Monday 23rd September Depart from Wesel train/bus station opposite Kaiserhof hotel, to arrive Hook of Holland ferry terminal then onto depart by Stena 14.15 daytime sailing (without a cabin) due to arrive Harwich International ferry terminal 19.45 20.15 board our coach for return to Felixstowe train station car park at about 21.30

We recommend a Stena Group booking to take advantage of any special offers.

Accommodation in Wesel - either a private host or a hotel? Kaiserhof Hotel is popular being in the town centre or Welcome Hotel by the Rhine promenade - a short walk away. Our Wesel Association friends can make booking reservations on our behalf.

Travel costs ? The figures for our October 2023 visit were -

1. UK coach (both ways including driver tip) £25 each (£50.50 double)
2. Single Foot passenger both ways and single cabin outward - £103 or Double foot passengers both ways and double cabin outwards £207
3. Coach Hook to Wesel and return. At the time of writing this newsletter - this is not known. Whatever the cost, it will be divided equally between those travelling, so the more who come the cheaper it will be, but it is bound to be at least the same as the UK coach fee.

Hotel prices - Kaiserhof - Jenny and I paid 125 Euros per night - double room and breakfast.
